

# Greystone Manor

SBE opens pop-aristocratic nightclub in former Industry space

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The location of SBE's latest Greystone Manor is a familiar one in the former-Industry, AREA, The Gate space along LA's La Cienega strip. SBE brings on designer Mark Zeff this installment to create the neoclassical mansion-inspired décor with heavy use of woodwork amongst 20-ft. ceilings with ornate moldings and actual gold-leaf gates. Visitors pass through an entrance foyer into a courtyard that leads to a modern-day ballroom with double staircase. LED-ignited chandeliers light the way amongst robust columns and two additional bars where aerial performers will be part of the weekly line-up above a center dance floor with smaller alcoves and VIP areas where celebs can hideout on velvet sofas and tufted-leather couches. Meant to evoke the feeling of a private estate, Greystone Manor shares a name with the original Doheny Mansion built in the early 20th Century that came to define the height of showy wealth – at least until its owner and rumored gay-lover were rumored to be killed by his wife. Scandals aside, a new foodie component to the club comes via Cleo-chef Danny Elmaleh who creates a menu of sharing plates like pear salads and short-rib grilled cheese sandwich likely not on the starlet diet.
